Summer Fun Tips From Sacred Heart Catholic School

This week's Summer Fun Idea is Making Your Own Finger Paint!

This recipe and craft idea comes from Gifts Kids Can Make.

Ingredients:

1/2 cup cornstarch 3 Tbsp sugar 1/2 tsp salt 2 cups cold water food coloring

Directions:

In a medium pan, mix all the ingredients together except the food coloring. Cook over low heat 10 to 15 minutes. Keep stirring the finger paint mixture until it is smooth and thick. After the mixture has thickened, take the pan off the stove and let cool.

After cooling, divide the finger paint into storage containers depending on how many colors you would like. Add a few drops of food coloring to each container. Stir the coloring in to the paint to determine the shade of color. You're ready to finger paint! Cover tightly for storing.
