Sacred Heart Catholic School

Well, we are back in session! In order to make this school year as successful as possible, here are a few hints that will help.

1. **Establish a bedtime routine.** A good nights sleep is essential for a child to have a good day at school. Believe it or not the recommended time of sleep for children 3 to 5 years old is 11 to 13 hours, for 6 to 12 years old is 9.25 to 10 hours of sleep.
2. **Establish a morning routine.** Experts encourage no television in the morning. Rather the experts recommend having the student do a puzzle or read a book if there is extra time in the morning. If you are like many families the morning is very hectic. Preparing the evening before helps to create a calmer morning. Before bedtime, lay out the child's clothes, pack the back pack, and put the back pack in a spot easy to access in the morning.
3. **Volunteer at your child's school.** The experts say that by volunteering at your child's school, your child will do better in school. The child sees you at school and makes the connection between home and school and the child also sees that education is important to you.

Sacred Heart Catholic School is pleased to welcome **three new teachers** to our Sacred Heart family. Mrs. Dana Pipkorn will be teaching kindergarten, Ms. Jolene Beran teaching third grade, and Mrs. Carolyn Reuter teaching sixth grade.
