**April is National Child Abuse Prevention Month.**  
Child abuse is behavior directed toward children that results in harm or injury or that seriously interferes with normal child development. The damage caused by child abuse is associated with school failure, criminality, drug and alcohol abuse, and physical and psychological problems. Each year there are over two million victims of child abuse and neglect in the United States.

**The children's session** will include information and education about emotional, physical, and sexual abuse. **The session for parents** will address nonviolent discipline, good communication between parents and children, and inform families about community resources.
